Seasonal Farm Activities

Students visiting the farm will participate in any number of seasonal farm activities depending on what is happening on the farm at the time of their visit. Possibilities include:

- Planting seeds or seedlings in the greenhouse or in the field
- Harvesting fruits and vegetables
- Weeding
- Mulching
- Pruning fruit trees
- Caring for our goats and chickens

A favorite site on the farm for past visitors has always been the animal pens. Students may have the opportunity to collect eggs from our hen house, milk the goats, or bottle feed their kids.

Planning Your Visit

Tailored Activities: We are happy to accommodate your curricular needs as best we can. Please let us know what your class is working on so we may design activities that supplement work being done in the classroom.
